ABOUT LIFECYCLE BUILDING CENTER



Lifecycle Building Center (LBC) is a nonprofit that works to reduce/repurpose construction solid waste and redirect affordable building materials to the community, including free materials to nonprofits through LBC's Nonprofit Material MATCH Program.

The heart of LBC is our **Building Material Reuse Retail Center** from which we sell or direct salvaged building materials to the public. The store is open to the general public five days a week (Tuesday through Saturday). LBC's pricing structure is between 50-85% below new material costs.

OUR MISSION

MISSION STATEMENT:

To make the lifecycle use of the built environment increasingly efficient and sustainable.

The mission of the LBC is to make the lifecycle use of the built environment increasingly efficient and sustainable. This mission is enacted in three ways.

- Through the operation of a retail building material reuse center as a workable and self-sufficient alternative to material disposal.
- By using proceeds from material sales to fund grassroots community outreach programs that educate community members and enhance resource efficiency in the built environment.
- By empowering the community with the educational and experiential resources needed to effectively raise market demand for green building goods and services.

LBC SERVICES

- Operation of a 70,000 square-foot building material reuse center that sells affordable building materials to the public and donates free materials to nonprofits, community groups, schools and houses of faith.
- Deconstruction services and material reclamation audits of construction and demolition projects.
- Donation pick-up services for useable building materials by our staff and trained volunteers.
- **Community workshops** which empower participants to reuse materials and help homeowners save energy/water, minimize hazardous conditions and improve the durability of their homes.
