ABOUT LIFECYCLE BUILDING CENTER



Lifecycle Building Center is a **community-based warehouse facility** that positively impacts communities and the environment by identifying and implementing best practice green building-related concepts. Our efforts reduce the cost and negative impact of solid waste disposal, promote resource efficiency, stimulate economic development, and empower every citizen to improve their own built environment.

The heart of the LBC concept is our large-scale material reuse retail center which enables LBC to **direct used building materials to the general public in lieu of disposal**. Revenue from the material reuse center are used to enact the LBC mission and creatively serve the community at large.

OUR MISSION

MISSION STATEMENT:

To make the lifecycle use of the built environment increasingly efficient and sustainable.

The mission of the LBC is to make the lifecycle use of the built environment increasingly efficient and sustainable. This mission is enacted in three ways.

- Through the operation of a retail building material reuse center as a workable and self-sufficient alternative to material disposal
- By using proceeds from material sales to fund grassroots community outreach programs that educate community members and enhance resource efficiency in the built environment
- By empowering the community with the educational and experiential resources needed to effectively raise market demand for green building goods and services

LBC SERVICES

- Operation of a 70,000 sq. ft. building material reuse center that sells affordable building materials to the public and donates free materials to non-profits, schools and houses of faith.
- Deconstruction services, deconstruction training and material reclamation audits of construction and demolition projects.
- Donation pick-up services for useable materials by our staff and trained volunteers.
- Community workshops which empower participants to reuse materials and help homeowners save energy/water, minimize hazardous conditions and improve the durability of their homes.

LBC IMPACT SINCE 2011

- Diverted close to 5.0 million pounds of reusable building materials from area landfills
- Donated free building materials to 160 nonprofit organizations
- Saved the community over \$2.5 million through deep discounts on building materials and avoided disposal fees
